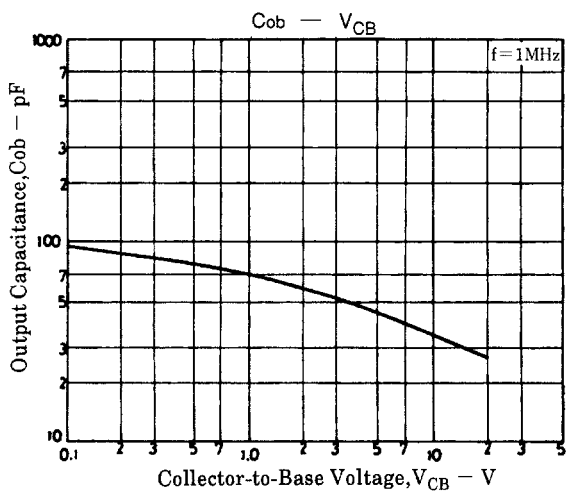
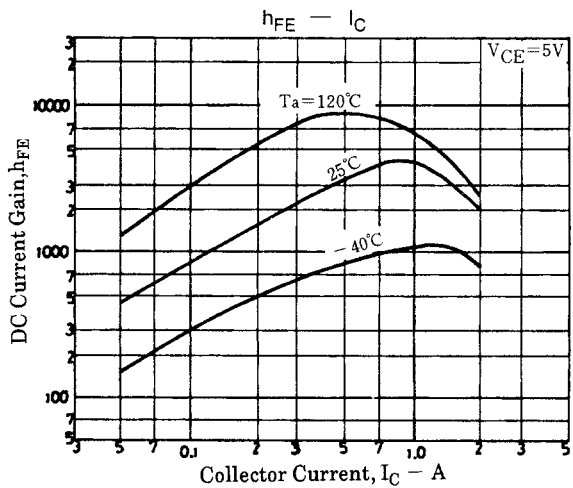
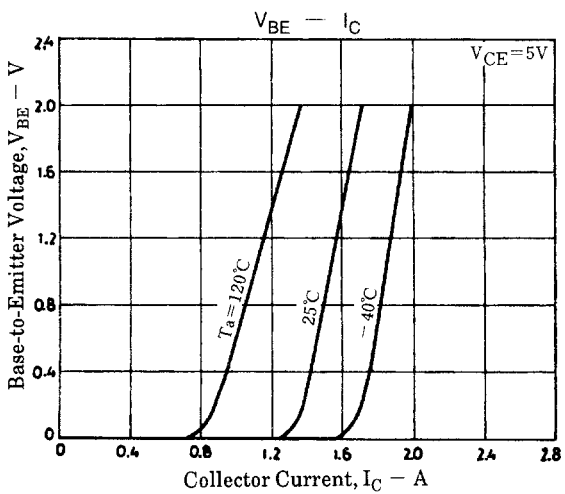
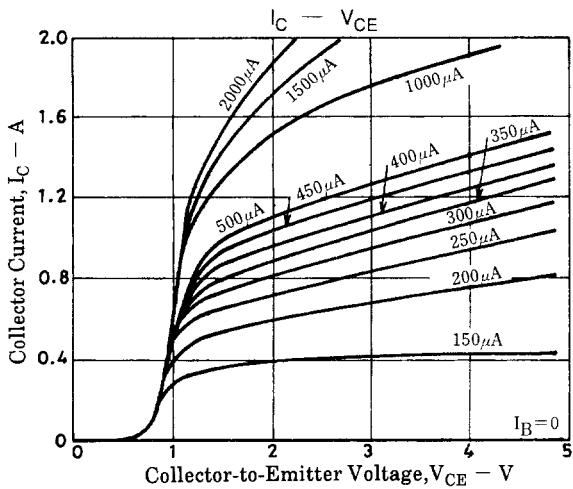
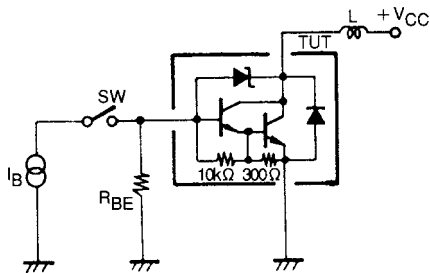
Switching Time Test Circuit

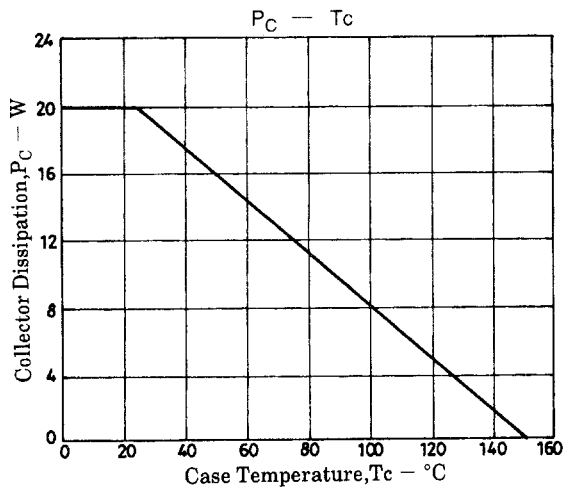
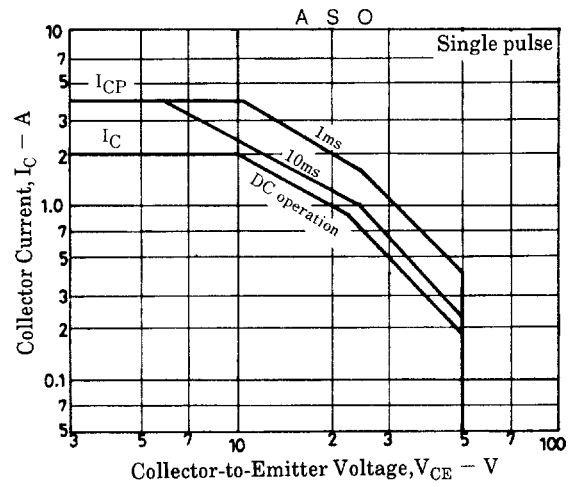
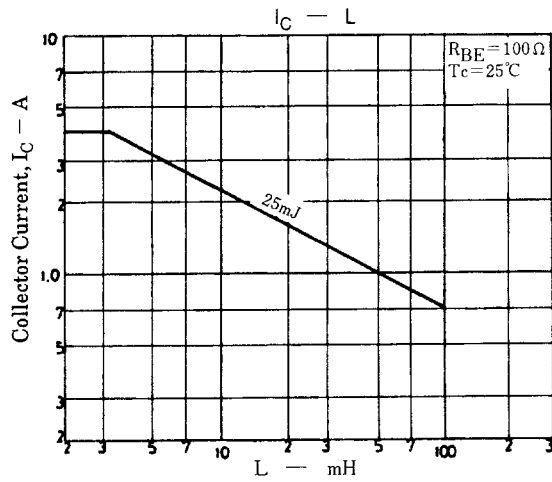
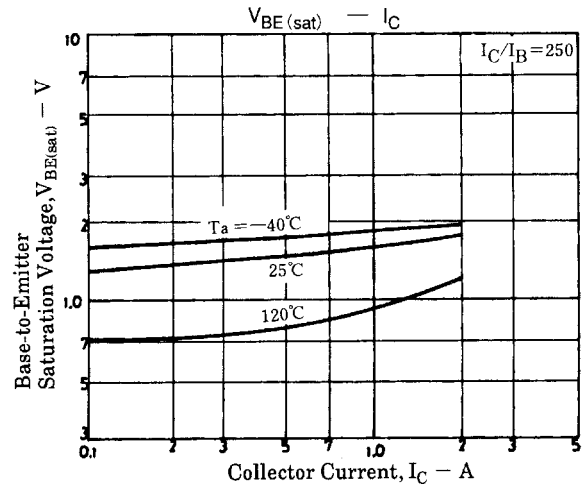
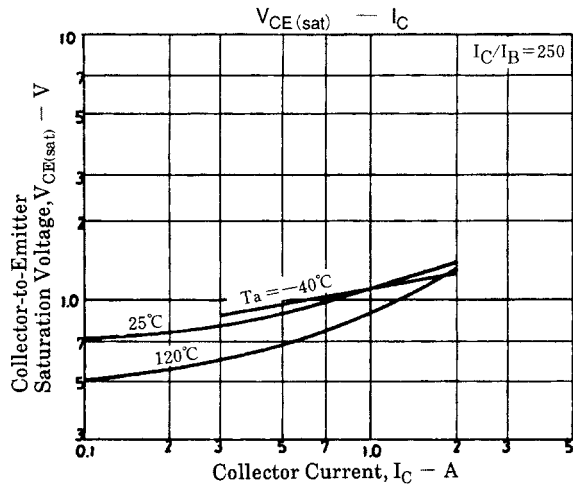
PW = 50 μ s, Duty Cycle $\leq$ 1%
