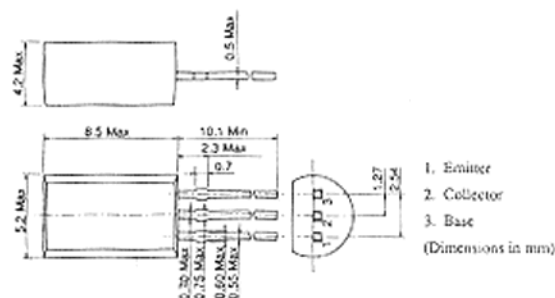

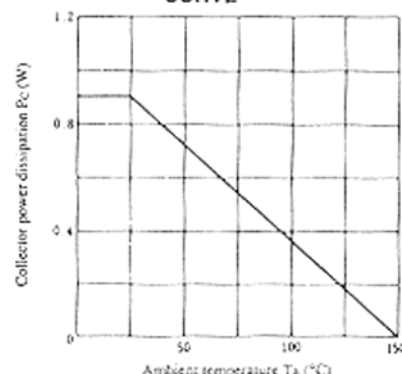

MAXIMUM COLLECTOR DISSIPATION CURVE



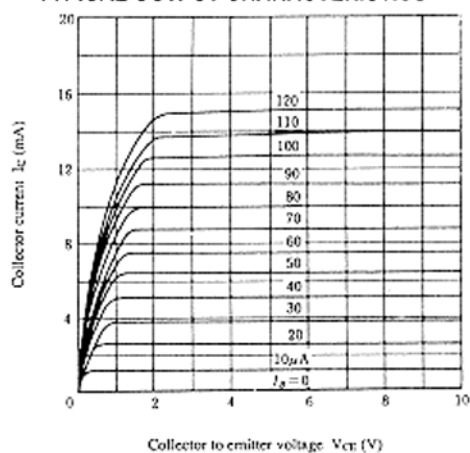

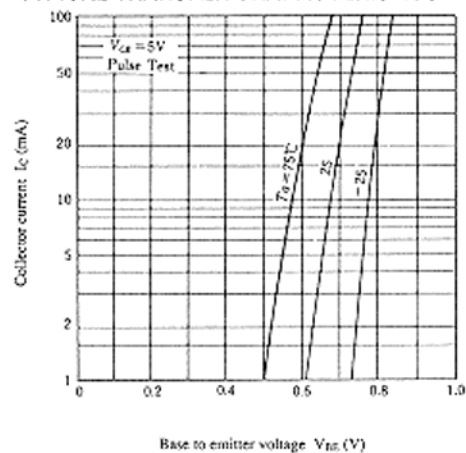

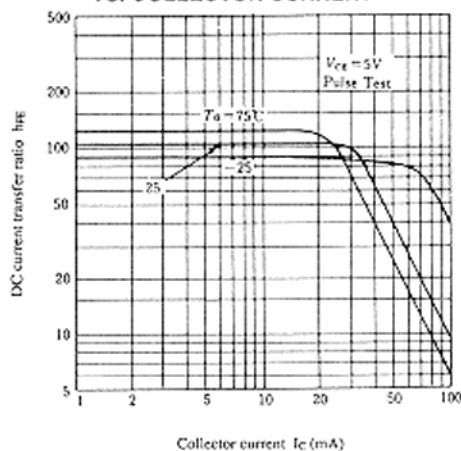
TYPICAL OUTPUT CHARACTERISTICS



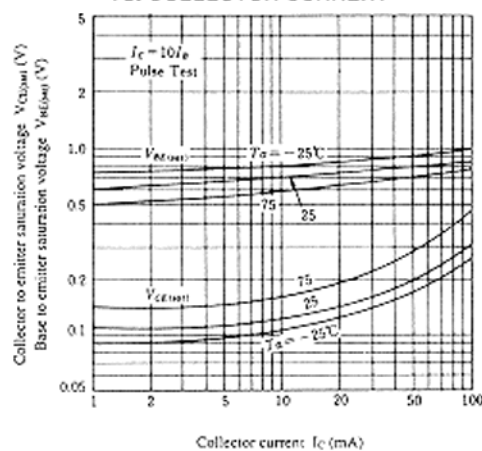
TYPICAL TRANSFER CHARACTERISTICS



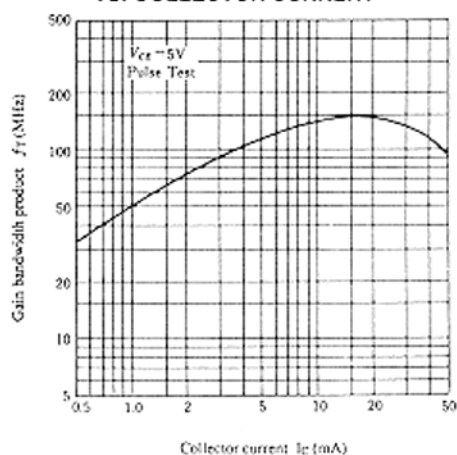
DC CURRENT TRANSFER RATIO VS. COLLECTOR CURRENT
